## **HOW TO FILL CARTRIGES OR CANDLE SHELLS (hereby referred to as Container below)**

**Please read ALL EASY STEPS carefully  
to avoid spills while pumping or pouring**

- 1 Unscrew the top of your container, holding it in one hand exactly as illustrated in photo (RIGHT)
- 2 Before pouring, make sure the squeeze bottle nozzle is flat side down, resting on container as shown
- 3 Squeeze bottle to pour liquid paraffin into your container to a fill level of 1/2" from top

**TO PREVENT SOAKED WICK FROM SPILLING ON YOU,  
ALWAYS USE HAND POSITION SHOWN AT RIGHT**

**For the first time filling, wait 20 minutes before lighting.  
This allows wick time to soak and prevents burning the cotton**

## **WICKS – HOW TO ADJUST AND REPLACE**

Wicks have a life of several months unless accidentally burned dry.

Replace the wick ONLY if flame is imperfect

### **DO NOT PULL OR TRIM WICK - REPLACE IT**

- 1 Unscrew the brass top of your container
- 2 Unscrew the THREADED barrel which holds the wick
- 3 Feed end of the new wick into hole in brass top and screw into the desired height (RIGHT)

## **HOW TO USE PUMP TO FILL BOTTLE**

Never fill directly from PUMP.  
Instead, use PUMP to fill BOTTLE first.

- 1 Affix tube extension to pump
- 2 Screw pump into the 2 ½ gallon Economy Jug
- 3 Position hands and bottle exactly as shown (LEFT) before pumping
- 4 Slowly pump and fill bottle
